Typical Ranger Items:

- Side out a carriageway or footway
- Clear mud and soil from the carriageway (non urgent)
- Hand sweep carriageway or footway (the routine sweeping service will continue to be provided by the District Council)
- Trim hedge to expose sign etc.
- Soil and seed verge
- Strim verge grass
- Rod and flush drain
- Clean out gully
- Rod and flush kerb drainage offlet
- Clear ditch
- Clear grip
- Wash sign, bollard or reflector post
- Repair minor kerb defect
- Repair minor footway surface defects


Following the ranger visit we will advise you of the work undertaken from your list, and if it has not been possible to complete any items, an explanation will be provided regarding the further action we intend to take.
